

Dr. Sarah Shelton has been elected President of the International Association of Correctional and Forensic Psychologists (IACFP). The IACFP is led by an international board of directors and has had a global presence for over 63 years. The mission of the IACFP is “to advance the development and implementation of evidence- and practitioner- informed policies and practices to support correctional and forensic psychologists who work with justice-involved individuals.”

Dr. Shelton’s six-year Presidential term with the IACFP begins, as she concludes her eight-year term of governance of the National Register of Health Service Psychologists, of which she is currently President and Chair of the Board. She is also a former President of the Kentucky Psychological Association and has served many other leadership roles within KPA and the American Psychological Association (APA).
