



KPA President Elected Chair of the National Register of Health Service Psychologists

Dr. Sarah Shelton, KPA President (2018) was recently elected Chair of the Board of Directors of the National Register of Health Service Psychologists in Washington, D.C. The nine-person Board is comprised of seven psychologists and two public representatives from across the U.S.

The National Register was established in 1974 and is the largest psychology credentialing entity and second largest psychology organization. Presently, the National Register membership includes more than 10,000 Psychologists and 3,500 Psychology Doctoral students/trainees.

Dr. Shelton was the youngest and first Early Career Psychologist ever elected to the Board of Directors six years ago. She is the youngest psychologist ever and the first psychologist from Kentucky to hold the Chair position.
